The Song challenge has been created to offer students pedagogical spaces to improve their level of English through a fun singing challenge.

MODALITIES

This English song challenge will have two categories: Soloist and duo. The singers in these modalities can be either women or men.

Soloist and duo singers: Interpretation quality and English pronunciation are assessed in this modality. Participants should bear in mind the following aspects:

For the final:

- √ Both men and women can participate.
- √ The songs must be sung in English.
- √ The songs mustn't be longer than 5 minutes.
- \checkmark Singers cannot participate in the two categories. They must select either soloist or duo modality to participate.

PARTICIPANTS

- \checkmark All the participants must be amateurs. By amateur we understand a person who engages in a study, sport, or other activity for pleasure rather than for financial benefit or professional reasons.
- \checkmark In case participants have unreleased songs, they are directly responsible for any claims that might be caused due to the use of lyrics, literary fragments or musical pieces that take part of the song in the challenge (See law 23 1982).

REQUIREMENTS

Registration:

- \checkmark Fill in the registration form completely, upload the Mp4 Video (please make sure to carefully select a song you like and record yourself in Mp4 format. Please remember that the video can last max 2 minutes).
- \checkmark To be a student in the universities that are participating.
